

Stonehaven Mens Outdoor Bowling Club Rules 2000
Amendment to Rule in 2004 (As Highlighted)

<p>1.</p> <p>(a) The club shall be called the, Stonehaven Bowling Club</p> <p>(b) The club is a non-profit making organization. All profits and surpluses will be used to improve the Clubs facilities. No profits or surpluses will be distributed other than to another non-profit making body members on winding up or dissolution of the Club.</p> <p>2.(a) The management of the club shall be in the hands of a Committee to be called the Management Committee, which shall be composed of (1) the office bearers, who shall consist of a President, Vice President, a Secretary, a Match Secretary and a treasurer, and (2) six ordinary members of whom the retiring President shall be one, holding office for one year, and each of the remaining five of whom shall hold office for a period of three years, shall be eligible for a re-election as an ordinary member of the committee.</p> <p>(b) At the Annual General Meeting prescribed in Rule 3, those ordinary members of the Management Committee who have been three years in office shall retire, and vacancies thereby created shall be filled at the said meeting.</p> <p>(c) No business shall be transacted by the Management Committee unless a quorum is present. For the purpose of this rule a quorum shall consist of five.</p> <p>(d) The Management Committee shall have power to appoint a Committee or Committees of their number and to prescribe their respective powers and duties.</p> <p>(e) The President and Vice President shall be ex officio members of all such Committees.</p> <p>(f) The Management Committee shall have the power to appoint any member of the Club to fill any casual vacancy which shall have occurred amongst the six ordinary members of the Committee, and any person so appointed shall hold office only for the remainder of such period as the deceased or retiring member would have held office had he remained a member of the Committee.</p> <p>3. A meeting of the club, to be called the Annual General Meeting shall be held annually on any suitable date in February for the purpose:-</p> <p>(a) Receiving a report from the Management Committee and a statement of account for the preceding year.</p> <p>(b) Electing office-bearer and ordinary members of the Management Committee for the ensuing year as prescribed in Rule 2 And</p> <p>(c) Transacting any other competent business.</p> <p>4. A special meeting of the Club may be called at any time by the Management Committee and shall be called by that committee on receiving of a written requisition to do so, signed by not less than thirty members of the club, specifying business proposed to be transacted at such meeting, in which event the notices convening such a General Meeting shall be issued by the management committee within ten days and the meeting be held within twenty days of the date on which the requisition was received by the Committee.</p>	<p>The President, and in his absence the Vice-President, shall preside at all meetings of the Club or of the Management Committee and in their absence any member of the Committee may be chosen by vote to preside.</p> <p>5. A written notice of the Annual General Meeting shall be published in the local press not less than seven days before the date appointed for such meeting, and the notice shall specify the place, date and time of the meeting, and the Agenda.</p> <p>6.(a) No business shall be conducted at an Annual General Meeting unless a quorum is present. For this rule, twenty shall be a quorum.</p> <p>(b) All decisions at a General Meeting shall be by a majority of those present and voting.</p> <p>(c) Votes at a General Meeting shall be taken either by show of hands or by ballot, as the meeting shall determine.</p> <p>(d) The president, and in his absence the Vice-President or Chairman of the meeting, shall have a casting as well as a deliberate vote at all meetings of the Management Committee and at all Annual General Meetings of the Club.</p> <p>7. Membership fees shall be fixed at the Annual General Meeting and shall be payable on or before the opening day of the season or on joining the Club.</p> <p>8. The Financial Year of the Club shall end on 31st December.</p> <p>9.(a) The Management Committee shall arrange all matches, with power to select players and rinks.</p> <p>(b) The Management Committee shall be responsible for the rules of all competitions played within the Club.</p> <p>(c) The Management Committee has the power to reimburse any reasonable expenses incurred by the Committee in the course of their duties, as defined by the Annual General Meeting.</p> <p>10. The rules and regulations framed by the Recreation Grounds Trustees shall be strictly observed.</p> <p>11. All inquiries, communications or complaints regarding the business of the Club shall be made in writing to the secretary, in order that they may be submitted to the Management Committee.</p> <p>12. Subject to the provisions of Rules 5 & 6 the rules may be altered at any Annual General Meeting.</p> <p>The foregoing rules were approved and adopted at the Annual General Meeting of the Club held 20th February 2000. Amendment, elected of a Match Secretary in the 2004 A.G.M. Was approved.</p>
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
